Sports Academy & High School PE Ski Trip

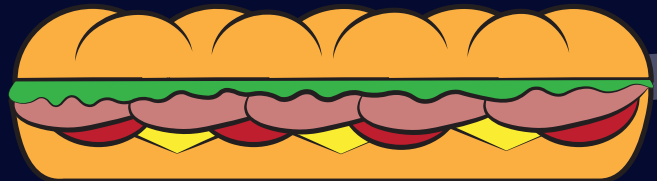

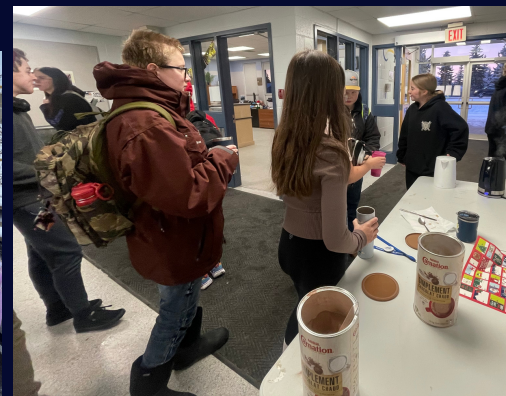
Hello Kodiak Family! December has been an exciting month for Leadership - we have complete a number of fun Christmas activities at the school:

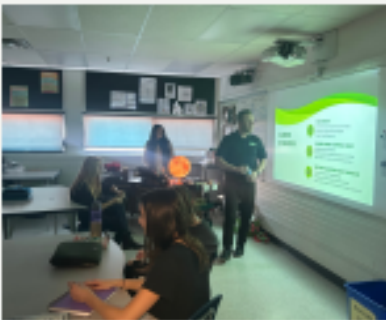

PERSONAL FINANCE: Explore personal financial literacy and management of personal finances. Combine theory and business math concepts to learn fundamental principles of short and long-term financial planning, budgeting, taxation, credit, insurance, investing and retirement.

HEALTH CARE AIDE: Explore the role and responsibilities of a Health Care Aide working in a variety of employment settings. The focus of this course is to share information that will result in safe, ethical, and respectful care based on the needs of the client.

PRINCIPLES OF PSYCHOLOGY I: Discover the fundamental terminology, procedures, findings, and theories related to basic psychological processes. Explore the history of nature of psychology and research methods in this field.

INTRODUCTORY SOCIOLOGY: Learn about sociological perspectives, methods, and concepts used to analyze social behaviour. Examine how culture, socialization, institutions, and interactions impact on social life.

Pipe Trades:

- Semester Two: Monday-Thursday (AM or PM)
- Students will gain skills in various aspects of the pipe trades – plumbing, steamfitting/pipefitting/gasfitting, sprinkler fitting, and B - pressure welding
- Earn industry credentials in fall protection and confined space in an industry setting by Journeyperson instructors

Pre-Employment (Welding or HET):

- Students will gain skills in first-year theory of HET or Welding apprenticeship
- Earn a Pre-Employment HET Certificate from Olds College (require 65%)
- Training takes place in the college setting by Journeyperson instructors
